

## REQUEST FOR BIDS

The Town of Richlands is now accepting sealed bid proposals for the resurfacing of certain streets within the corporate limits. Asphaltic material must comply with all applicable VDOT specifications. All surface tie-ins to existing pavement must be milled. Bids will be accepted on a “per ton applied” unit basis and the approximate tonnage needed is approximately 4,240 tons. Certified bids will be accepted from contractors utilizing a self-propelled paver and must be rolled with a five-ton minimum roller. Contractor will be responsible for traffic control personnel and shall have 60 days from the “Notice to Proceed” to complete all resurfacing, unless a change is mutually agreed upon by the Town and the Contractor. A pre-bid construction meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. at the Richlands Town Hall, 200 Washington Square. THIS MEETING IS MANDATORY. A list of the streets scheduled for resurfacing under this proposal is available at the Richlands Town Hall; business hours 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Monday through Friday.

Sealed bid proposals will be accepted at the Richlands Town Hall, 200 Washington Square, Richlands, Virginia 24641, until 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, July 16, 2015. The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept the proposal, which in its opinion, is in the best interest of the Town.

The bidder and its subcontractors must comply with the provisions of Executive Order 11246, which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin. Bidders must certify that they do not, and will not, maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated on a basis of race, color, creed, or national origin.

Minority/Women Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) are encouraged to bid. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
